Introduction to Design and Production (Fall 2017, Fall 2018, Fall 2019, Spring 2020, Spring 2023)

A team-taught course, focusing on the basic principles of theatrical design, from ideas of color, space, and composition to the basic principles of theatrical production. The course uses a combination of labs, projects, and lectures to explore a variety of topics related to the areas of scenery, costumes, lights, sound, and projections. A cursory examination of the tools, softwares, and construction methodologies involved in each field prepares the student for study in the upper level design courses at Wake.

First Year Seminar: Graphic Storytelling (Fall 2017, Fall 2018, Spring 2022, Fall 2022, Fall 2024)

Using graphic novels from *Watchmen* to *Fun Home*, the course explores the use of the superhero narrative throughout the 20th and 21st centuries, and the ways in which writers across many different ethnic, religious, and gender divides use the framework to tell stories of fantasy, history, and family. The course focuses on a heavy discussion component as well as a writing component.

First Year Seminar: Crying Wolf: Storytelling and the Moral Imagination (Spring 2020, Spring 2021)

A team-taught course, the ways in which cultural context and upbringing create and shape the moral compass we use to explore our daily lives are the focus of this First Year Seminar. Exploring the use of fables and moral storytelling from around the world, the course also challenges students to engage with moral imaginations outside of their own context.

Introduction to Design and Production for Dance (Spring 2017, Spring 2018, Spring 2019, Spring 2020, Spring 2021, Spring 2022, Spring 2023, Spring 2024)

A team-taught course, focusing on the basic principles of theatrical design, from ideas of color, space, and composition to the basic principles of theatrical production, as they relate to dance. The course uses a combination of labs, projects, and lectures to explore a variety of topics related to the areas of scenery, costumes, lights, sound, and projections and their applications in the setting of a dance piece. A study of sound editing, costume rendering, projections software, and lighting console programming give student choreographers an understanding of the languages of design, to augment their conversations and collaboration with designers.

Introduction to Theatre (Spring 2017, Spring 2018, Fall 2019, Summer 2020, Spring 2021, Spring 2024, Spring 2025)

Using theatre history from Ancient Greece to the present, the course explores both the history of theatre as well as the process of creating theatre. Used in progress professional jobs to shed additional light on a career in the American theatre. Read a sampling of plays throughout the periods examined, as well as from a variety of cultural and ethnic backgrounds, and used a creative project as well as group explorations of conceptual storytelling to further immerse the students in the process of producing a play.

Lighting Design (Fall 2016, Fall 2018, Fall 2019, Fall 2021, Fall 2023)

With a focus on the artistry, story-telling skills, and technology inherent in lighting design, the course explores not only the objectives of lighting design, but the variable qualities of light manipulated to execute those objectives. The course also touches on color theory and the principles of electricity needed to execute effective lighting design. A focus is paid to close readings of a script, storyboarding ideas and translating those notions to a computer drafted light plot. The final project culminates in a study of electronic lighting control, as the students use the light board to create a light show to an assigned piece of music. In the fall of 2019, a cross-curricular collaboration with our directing II course allowed the students to design lights for fully realized scenes.

Sound and Projections Design (Spring 2019, Spring 2021, Spring 2023, Spring 2025)

With a focus on the artistry, story-telling skills, collaborative spirit, and technology connected to sound and projections design, the course explores both disciplines through the lens of process and execution. How to talk with directors, close readings of the script, and a focus on the technical challenges inherent in the form create a holistic approach to sound and projections as a design discipline. In the spring of 2021, the course was co-taught, with a cross-curricular collaboration with our studio series productions, with the students designing sound for realized productions.

Stage Management (Fall 2021, Fall 2022, Fall 2023, Fall 2024)

Using professional contacts, a close reading of the text, and the current mainstage production, the course explores the various pieces of paperwork, the communicative techniques, and the personality traits present in contemporary professional stage manager. The course incorporates paperwork, running rehearsals, communication, production meetings, and calling cues to explore a holistic view of the role of a stage manager in a contemporary American theatre setting.

Independent Study (Fall 2017, Spring 2018, Spring 2019, Spring 2020, Fall 2024, Spring 2025)

A variety of independent studies, ranging in topics from advanced lighting design, light board programming, advanced sound design, work as an electrician in the theatre, and an introduction to the process of sound design. Each study featured a different selection of hands-on learning and a one-on-one lecture component.

International Teaching Experience (Albania)

Intro to Lighting Design and Audio Editing (Fall 2018)

Taught an accelerated version of Lighting Design and a master class on audio editing at Teatri Metropol in Tirana, Albania. The students were a mix of University students and young professionals in the field.

Adjunct Faculty-Furman University Greenville, SC (2013-2016)

Sound Design (Fall 2015)

With a focus on the artistry and story-telling inherent in good design, the course explores the tools at the disposal of the Sound Designer, from the use of underscoring and ambient sounds to the nature and quality of musical genres throughout the centuries. The course also briefly examines the science and qualities of sound and the basic principles behind live sound reinforcement. A heavy focus is also paid to Qlab and sound cue playback software, as well as digital audio workstations, culminating in projects that require a synthesis of art and technological knowledge.

Introduction to Theatre (Fall 2013-2016)

Using theatre history from Ancient Greece to the present, the course explores both the history of theatre as well as the process of creating theatre. Used in progress professional jobs to shed additional light on a career in the American theatre. Read a sampling of plays throughout the periods examined and used a creative project as well as group explorations of conceptual storytelling to further immerse the students in the process of producing a play.

Sound Editing and Playback for the Theatre (February 2014)

Taught a one-day workshop exploring the use of Audacity and Qlab in sound editing, design and playback. Students learned to record voice-overs using readily available equipment, learned to edit and alter those recordings and incorporated music and sound effects to create unique sound-scapes.

Gobos for the Stage (January 2014)

Taught a one-day workshop exploring the use of patterns in theatrical lighting fixtures. Explored the basics of a theatrical lighting fixture and the hanging of those fixtures before moving into the use of patterns to aid in the visual storytelling of lighting design.

Ideas in the Arts (Fall 2013)

Co-taught a class using the intersection of Music, Visual Arts and Theatre as a jumping off point for a cursory examination of each discipline in the context of Edo period Japanese culture as well as the 20th century. We used *Red*, *Amadeus* and *The Love Suicides at Sonezaki* as well as a filmed performance of *Madame Butterfly* to explore theatre and its intersections with both Music and Visual Art.

Warehouse Theatre Teaching Artist, Greenville, SC (2012-2017)

Working with a variety of demographics including middle school, high school and adults, we used the actor's approach to Shakespeare to unlock reading comprehension and deeper understanding of Shakespeare's plays. We also used playwriting and storytelling to help adults through the Greenville Literacy Association with writing skills and public speaking, as well as using the act of telling a story as a means to develop a sense of community amongst the students and volunteers of the GLA.

South Carolina Children's Theatre Teaching Assistant, Greenville, SC (2008-2009)

Assisted the teaching artists of the South Carolina Children's Theatre, working with children from K3 to middle school, focusing on introductory acting technique.

Warehouse Theatre Journeyman Instructor, Greenville, SC (2008-2009)

Using the Wooden O curriculum program of the Warehouse Theatre, team-taught 3-4 day workshops on the actors' approach to Shakespeare, using performance tools and textual analysis, to a variety of Greenville area high schools, culminating each with a performance of an abridged *Hamlet*, during which I played the parts of Claudius and the Ghost.

Bridges to a Brighter Future Improv Instructor, Greenville, SC (2006-2008)

Taught introductory short-form improvisation for 3 summers with the Bridges to a Brighter Future program on the Furman campus. The coursework, focused on the fundamentals of improvisation (character/relationship/objective/where) and culminated in a performance in front of the entire program, using the games that had been taught during the session in the performance.

Bridges to a Brighter Future Drama Instructor, Greenville, SC (2006)

Taught an introduction to acting course with the Bridges to a Brighter Future program, without a final performance component, focusing on basic character and objective based work, and using warm ups and ensemble-focused activities to give the students a deeper understanding of not only the performing arts, but of the ways in which those skills can be used in personal and professional development.
